### **SELF PAY**

Students have the option of making monthly payments for tuition and supplies if the training program is at least three months in length. Payments are due by the fifth of each month. Today's auto body technicians must be trained in the construction of the automobile body and framework. Automobile production uses materials and manufacturing techniques that demand that the auto body repair technician be competent in metalworking, welding, uni-body construction, surface preparation, spray painting, and accurate repair estimating. Students use safe and modern repair equipment in all phases of their training.

Most of these vehicles are powered by diesel engines. The diesel truck technology course trains its students in the repair and servicing of diesel-powered equipment. Special emphasis is placed on the direct needs of local business and industry. Technical knowledge is enhanced by "hands-on" work involving actual maintenance activities of school owned vehicles and equipment. While the emphasis is on diesel engines, biodiesel engines, gasoline powered equipment and vehicles are also included as part of the instructional program.
