If additional hours are needed to complete the program after year one, the tuition for the third semester will be re-calculated and may increase.

HEATING, VENTILATION & AIR CONDITIONING

Program Description: Students in this program become entry level HVAC technicians and mechanics. Students will learn technical tasks including: assembling and installing air and gas systems; cutting, reaming and threading piping materials; waterproofing and sealing joints; testing entire systems for leaks through the use of pressure testing devices; installing gas and water plumbing fixtures and equipment; reading and implementing blue-print drawings; and designing plumbing and heating systems. An important part of the technical training covers instruction on how to install, diagnose, service and maintain residential and commercial control wiring for HVAC systems.

-Once your account is set up, you can then login and view all the class materials. Mr. Kosker will provide you a copy of the course manual and any additional handouts.
